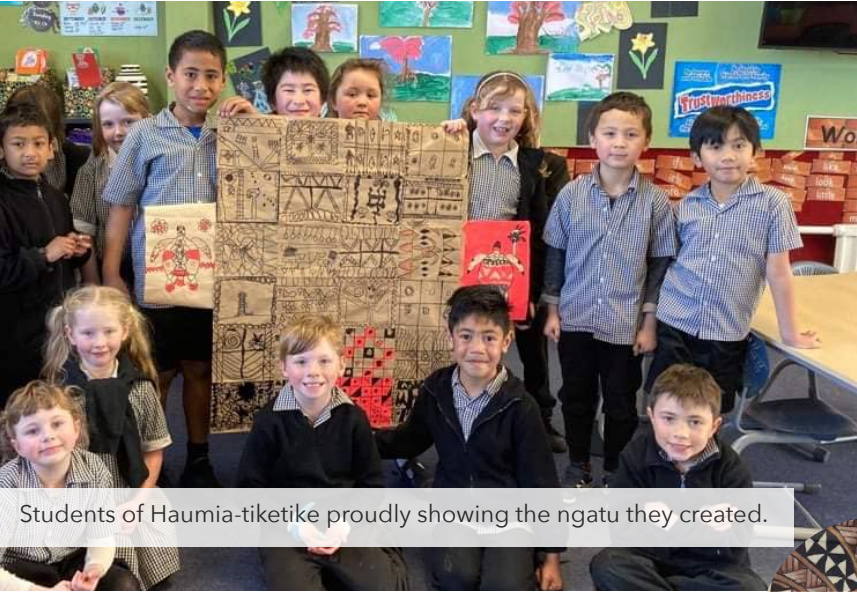


TONGA LANGUAGE WEEK

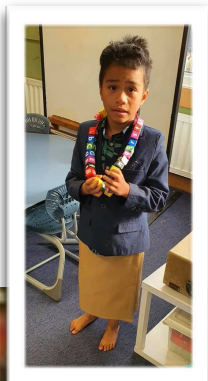
The students of Bathgate Park School had a wonderful time learning about the beautiful Kingdom of Tonga.

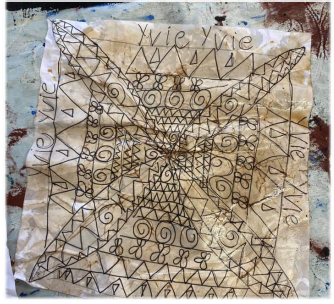
